

Carolyn

Carolyn was picking up her nine-month-old daughter, Sarah, from her ex-husband's house after work and noticed Sarah had a cut lip and her face was red. Carolyn noticed that her ex-husband had been drinking and when she asked about Sarah, he told her that he caused the injuries. Carolyn went to the police, but no arrest was made because the father denied hitting the child to the police and further denied that he told Carolyn he was responsible for Sarah's injuries. He gave different versions of the story to different interviewers. In the meantime, Sarah had to be hospitalized for several days due to a brain hemorrhage as a result of the abuse. Since they were not married,



Carolyn was allowed to withhold Sarah from her ex-husband. When he began to send Carolyn harassing text messages, she sought an emergency order of protection. In court, Prairie State was able to obtain a two-year order of protection as well as full custody without visitation for Carolyn. The father was required to undergo alcohol assessment and domestic violence counseling. If he completes these, his visitation rights will be

re-evaluated.

Brandon

Brandon, a primary school-aged boy, was born with severe physical deformities including webbed feet and hands and digestive disabilities that required him to rely on a feeding tube. Brandon had been receiving Social Security benefits based on these disabilities. His doctor tried removing the feeding tube as a temporary experiment, but that proved unsuccessful in improving Brandon's condition. Despite this, Brandon's benefits were cut under the notion that he no longer needed the feeding tube. In addition, the doctor also performed some corrective surgery on his hands and feet to improve the use of his hands. This was another reason his benefits were cut, even though Brandon still suffered significant functional abilities. Prairie State was able to prove that despite the surgery, Brandon still needed assistance and that removing the feeding tube was a temporary experiment to see how Brandon's health would respond. His health benefits were then reinstated.



Maya

Maya, a single mother of four children, including one daughter who is autistic and requires special services at school, had a job, but it didn't pay enough to take care of her and her family. The fathers of Maya's children were not providing her any financial assistance. Maya also has her own chronic health issues. During tax season, Maya paid someone to file her taxes. Unfortunately, the tax preparer scammed Maya and filed returns that inflated her income so as to establish tax refunds. Thus, Maya lost her Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher. On the verge of losing her home, Maya came to Prairie State. Prairie State was able to help Maya file amended returns and get her Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher

back, allowing her to remain in her home.



Kendall's application for public housing was denied

due to a prior eviction. This prior eviction occurred at a time when Kendall was living with her mother. She was over 18 and was added to the lease, even though she had no money and was caring for her baby full-time. After her mother was evicted, Kendall went back to high school and graduated. She then got a part-time job and was promoted to full-time due to her hard work. Despite all of this, Kendall's application for public housing was denied. Kendall had essentially been homeless—living with her grandmother or in hotels because she couldn't afford a security deposit and rent on her income. Kendall came to Prairie State, where we were able to argue that Kendall needed housing assistance and had shown her responsibility and worthiness by graduating high school and getting a full-time job, as well as explaining that she was not responsible for the prior eviction that occurred when she was younger and living with her mom. The hearing officer agreed and approved Kendall's application. She now has an affordable home for her and her child.

John

After suffering a flare-up of his MS (multiple sclerosis), John had to stop working. He became depressed at the time he was found disabled, and his social worker suggested that he try working part-time to combat his depression. John did this while remaining within the income limits of Social Security requirements. However, because of the timing of his checks, he sometimes received pay in a given month that exceeded the SGA (substantial gainful activity) level, which caused the Social Security Administration (SSA) to claim an overpayment of benefits. SSA claimed that John had returned to work and because of this, he was no longer disabled and the payments he earned were an overpayment. He was charged \$58,047 in repayment fees. Prairie State was able to convince the local SSA office that the months in which checks exceeded the SGA amount were months in which John received pay based on days worked in a previous month or vacation pay, which is not counted in the SGA calculation. SSA revised the alleged

overpayment amount from \$58,047 to zero.



Diane

When Diane's ex-husband took a check from her that she was going to use to pay rent, she told him that she didn't want to see him again.

Despite her telling him to never contact her

again, he came to her apartment, forced his way inside, and physically assaulted her. This was not the first time he was physically abusive towards her. He abused her during their marriage, too. Diane came to Prairie State seeking an order of protection against her ex-husband. Her ex-husband verbally harassed Diane during the hearing and the judge granted Diane her order of protection. Additionally, Diane was living paycheck-to-paycheck and was behind in rent for the amount her husband had stolen from her. Prairie State was able to obtain a grant on her behalf so that she could catch up in rent.

Martin

Martin came to Prairie State when he had to leave his Section 8 voucher-subsidized apartment because the landlord lost the property through foreclosure. The foreclosure, and subsequent landlord disappearance, created many problems for Martin—including a hastened move and the loss of his security deposit. Martin lived with his daughter while searching for an appropriate and accessible apartment in which to use his voucher, but was unable to do so before it expired. He had tremendous difficulty finding an apartment in the area without a ready security deposit.

Prairie State represented Martin in a housing authority administrative hearing to reverse the expiration of his voucher. We made a reasonable accommodation argument and preserved his housing subsidy. He has finally found an apartment and will receive monetary assistance for his security deposit from a grant Prairie State helped secure for him.



Andi

Andi was in the process of moving out of her rented apartment, but still had possessions there and slept there some nights. She was behind in rent and the landlord had given her a five-day notice, but without going to court, the landlord locked Andi out and her remaining property in the unit. Prairie State called the landlord and convinced him to let Andi into the apartment to retrieve her property. However, the landlord texted her repeatedly, threatening to sue her and ruin her credit. The landlord then filed a small claims suit, demanding \$4,000 for the back rent, all future rent on the one-year lease, damages, and storage fees for keeping the client's property during the lock-out. Prairie State defended the client in the small claims case and filed a motion to dismiss the rent claims, and prevailed. The court allowed the landlord to refile a claim for damages to the unit. However, the landlord failed to give Andi an itemized list of the alleged damages to the unit as required by the Security Deposit Return Act. Rather than entering judgment in favor of the landlord, the court ordered him to return \$654 to Andi.
